Privacy Notice Statement

Thank you for your interest in participating in the Canadian Congress on Disability Inclusion (CCDI) 2023 event. This is a privacy notice statement, which will explain how we may use personal information you provide us.

The Canadian Congress on Disability Inclusion (CCDI) 2023 is a national event that is hosted by Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC). It is a virtual event held in advance of the National AccessAbility Week (NAAW). The purpose of CCDI is advancing accessibility and disability inclusion consistent with the objectives of the *Accessible Canada Act*. CCDI will be held from May 24 to May 26, 2023.

During the event, ESDC may collect photos, images, audio and/or video excerpts that contain your personal information, including your name, expressions, image, likeness or voice. The purposes of collection, if you consent, are to plan for and /or promote future CCDI conferences or any other NAAW related events by internally and publicly sharing promotional materials.

The collection of this information is authorized under section 5(1) *Department of Employment and Social Development Act* and section 11 of the *Accessible Canada Act*, and all your personal information will be administered and protected in accordance with the *Department of Employment and Social Development Act*, the *Privacy Act*, and all other applicable laws. You have the legal right to the protection of, access to, and where applicable, correction of your personal information, which is described in the ESDC's Personal Information Bank PSU 938 for [Outreach Activities](#). To access this information, please follow the instructions in [Info Source](#) (<https://www.Canada.ca/infosource-ESDC>). You also have the right to file a complaint with the

[Privacy Commissioner of Canada](https://www.priv.gc.ca/en/report-a-concern/) (https://www.priv.gc.ca/en/report-a-concern/) if you have any concerns about the way your personal information is being handled.

Participation in the congress is voluntary and you may withdraw your participation at any time. Your decision to withdraw your participation will have no impact on your current or future use of or access or entitlement to any Government of Canada service.

Your personal information will be retained by ESDC for 10 years from this date and will be stored and protected in accordance with the Treasury Board *Policy on Government Security; Policy on Service and Digital; Directive on Service and Digital; Directive on Security Management*; the ESDC Storage of Electronic Information Directive; and, finally, the *Standard for Electronic Documents and Records Management Solutions* (EDRMS).

The vFairs platform is an event technology service with datacentres located in Canada. All data from CCDI 2023 will remain in Canada.
