



# TEACHER GUIDE



### Description

The Career Exploration Centre is a virtual open access self exploratory experience. The independent online learning platform will help all students aged 13-18 increase their knowledge and awareness of trends and emerging career opportunities while guiding and preparing them to make informed career choices in the future. They will have a better understanding of their potential, a plan for post-secondary education, additional training, and a clear pathway to a career.

### Learning outcomes

- Students assess their values, skills, and interests and use that information to evaluate potential careers.
- Explore career sectors and learn about different jobs.
- Better understand the education and training needed for different careers.
- Gain knowledge about grants, scholarships and internships to support different pathways.

### Recommended use

The Career Exploration Centre can be used as a learning resource for your students in the following ways:

- As a standalone activity or extension of a JA World of Choices, Skilled Trades Summit or other career exploration event, where students can learn more about different career paths.
- As a guided exploration activity using the sample discussion prompts.
- As self-directed student exploration
